Request for donation

At the beginning of war in BIH, I was seriously wounded (in massacre on 27th of May 1992), which eventually led to amputations of both of my lower extremities. Due to extreme loss of blood, I required several blood transfusions which were unfortunately carrying the most dangerous type of Hepatitis C virus.



The wounding that day had other unforeseen consequences later in my life. Namely, I developed a rare bone marrow cancer (myeloma) due to grenade shrapnel in one of my leg bones (femur). This, coupled with onslaught of liver cirrhosis due to the aggressive Hepatitis C has left me in incredibly weakened condition.

As a result, I am no longer able to walk using my leg prosthesis for any extended period of time.

I currently reside downtown Sarajevo on the third floor of an apartment building. Whenever I need to go the hospital (which is quiet often lately) I need to burden my friends and family to carry me in and out of the building. To resolve this very difficult situation, I require an elevator installed in my building. An architectural project has been completed, and the cost of such undertaking is estimated at 26.500 Euros.

I am currently attempting to secure the necessary funds for this project. For this purpose account will be opened to receive all donations.

I kindly beseech you to donate to this fund according to your means, to help solve this life crippling problem.
